Synopsis of Bill

HB 689 appropriates \$35 thousand from the general fund to the Board of Regents of New Mexico State University for expenditure in FY06 to expand and enhance the music department and jazz band at the Alamogordo branch.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The request was not on the list of priority projects submitted by New Mexico State University to the CHE for review. Consequently, this request was not included in the Commission's funding recommendation for FY06.

The appropriation of \$35 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY06 shall revert to the general fund.
