SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 870 appropriates \$150,000 from the general fund to the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) for county disaster relief assistance.

Significant Issues

According to DFA, within the Department of Public Safety, Office of Emergency Management, there is a Disaster Assistance Program that helps provide financial assistance from the Governor's Disaster Relief Fund. Applicants for the Disaster Assistance Program must be either political subdivisions of the State or non-profit organizations which fulfill a governmental role within the community they serve. This includes all NM Counties. The types of disasters that are eligible are: debris removal; emergency protective devices (i.e. dikes, sandbagging, etc.); roads & related structures; water control facilities; public buildings, vehicles & equipment; public utilities; parks and recreation & other. NM Association of Counties are in support of this legislation.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$150,000 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY06 shall revert to the general fund.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

DFA noted the proposed legislation provides for a total funding appropriation of \$150,000; however, provides no definition for "disaster", no criteria for disbursement, and/or procedures on disbursement.
