#### **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

HB 960 amends the Public Health Act restricting the administration of ultrasonagraphy or ultrasound to that performed pursuant to an order or referral from a licensed physician, nurse practioner, certified nurse midwife or physician assistant and mandates fines to include possible imprisonment.

### Significant Issues

Ultrasonagraphy or ultrasound is a diagnostic tool used in a variety of health care settings and situations. Nurse Practitioners use this diagnostic tool and subsequently treat their patients. A Nurse Practitioner must write an order for the patient to receive this type of care. Based on the results of the ultrasound, a diagnosis is made for the patient with subsequent appropriate care being provided.

## House Bill 960 -- Page 2

Inappropriate use of this diagnostic tool could result in individuals receiving false diagnostic information. This could result in delayed care for the individual and the potential for a bad health care outcome.
