SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 13 makes findings related to the negative impact of increasing medical malpractice awards and malpractice insurance premiums and calls upon the New Mexico congressional delegation to support the President's medical malpractice liability reform proposal.

Significant Issues

The President's medical malpractice liability reform proposal would limit non-economic awards to no more than \$250 thousand. According to DOH, this cap is lower than New Mexico's cap of \$600 thousand. New Mexico law provides two other protections which would not be pre-empted by federal law, including a review by a commission before a claim is brought to court and a time limit in which claims can be filed.
