#### Synopsis of Bill

House Resolution 2 would amend House Rule 9-1 by requiring the consent of the majority and minority floor leaders for appointments to committees.

### Significant Issues

House Rule 9-1 currently provides that the speaker shall appoint all committees created by the house, except those where the members are designated in the motion creating them. House Resolution 2 would amend this rule, to read:

The speaker shall appoint all committees created by the house, provided that appointments of members of the majority party and minority party shall be by and with the consent of the majority floor leader and minority floor leader, respectively, except those committees where the members are designated in the motion creating them, and all appointments shall be announced in open session and made a matter of record in the journal.
