SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 911 appropriates \$500 thousand from the general fund to the Martin Luther King Commission for a peace conference to be held in Santa Fe and planned in cooperation with the King center in Atlanta.

Significant Issues

MLK supports such a conference in New Mexico. The conference would identify current issues and new programs that are successful throughout the country. It would also provide an opportunity to recognize NM citizens who have promoted the principles and philosophy of MLK.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$500 thousand contained in this bill is a non-recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY06 shall revert to the general fund.
