SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 924 appropriates \$20 thousand from the general fund to Teacher Professional Development Fund for the purpose of funding teacher development in the West Las Vegas School District in the areas of science, mathematics and technology.

Significant Issues

The bill provides funding for teacher professional development in critical curricula areas.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

PED the bill indirectly relates to performance measures on percent of highly qualified teachers in the classroom.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$20 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall not revert.

The LFC FY06 appropriation recommendation is balanced between revenues and expenditures and any increase in recurring funding must be offset by reductions in other areas of the recommendation. The Legislature must consider all priorities and funding requirements to find revenue to support this legislation.
