SUMMARY

Synopsis of SRC Amendment

The Senate Rules Committee amendment to Senate Memorial 27 clarifies that the Oil Conservation Division as a part of its review will solicit input from stakeholder groups and further specifies members of those groups. The amendment further requests the division report its findings to the LFC and the revenue stabilization and tax policy committee by December 1, 2005.

Synopsis of Original Bill

The memorial requests the Oil Conservation Division conduct a study, with input from stakeholder groups, of the adequacy of the Oil and Gas Act to provide authority for effective regulation of the oil and gas industry and of the adequacy of the staffing and funding of OCD to carry out that mission.

OCD is requested to report its conclusions and recommendations (including proposed amendments to the act) to the 2006 session of the Legislature.
