## A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO TO PROTECT WORKERS FROM UNION VIOLENCE.

WHEREAS, every American has the right to expect a workplace free of violence; and

WHEREAS, some labor unions have resorted to violence, bribery and extortion in their workplace unionization campaigns; and

WHEREAS, this violence has not confined itself to the workplace but has spilled over into other areas of American civic life, including political campaigns; and

WHEREAS, the American people have a constitutional right to expect that their exercise of free speech be respected by their fellow citizens and protected by law; and

WHEREAS, congress has, in the past, sought to restrict .154341.1
