25	WHEREAS, a reasonable cap on damage awards protects

WHEREAS, victims who suffer losses, not victims' attorneys, should receive the largest share of damage awards; and

WHEREAS, medical malpractice reforms that enact caps on damage awards, allow for the inclusion of collateral source payments in jury considerations and impose time limits on the filing of lawsuits will enhance access to health care, lower medical insurance premiums and lower the cost of health care;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico congressional delegation be requested to support the president of the United States' medical malpractice liability reform; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to all members of the New Mexico congressional delegation.
