legislative council be requested to create an interim veterans'
affairs oversight committee to work with the veterans' services
department, the department of military affairs and related
agencies to:

A. review the functions of state agencies and
tribal entities involved in providing services to veterans to
determine if the present division of responsibilities for
veterans' affairs among state agencies and tribal entities can
be improved for greater efficiency;

B. review state statutes related to veterans' and
military affairs for consistency and potential conflict;

15 C. review the needs of veterans and the services
16 provided by federal, state and tribal governments to determine
17 if veterans' needs are being appropriately met; and

18 D. make recommendations for legislative initiatives19 to address the findings of the committee; and

oversight committee develop recommendations by November 30,
2005 to assist the veterans' services department in formulating
legislative proposals necessary to implement its
