WHEREAS, the management of Los Alamos national laboratory by a consortium of New Mexico's three research universities may prove to be both more efficient and more beneficial than having management by the university of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university and the New Mexico institute of mining and technology be requested to study the feasibility of a consortium of these three institutions of higher education negotiating or bidding for management of Los Alamos national laboratory; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the presidents of the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university and the New Mexico institute of mining and technology.
