10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 9, SECTION 14 OF THE
12 CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PERMIT THE STATE TO ESTABLISH BY
13 LAW A PROGRAM THAT PERMITS THE TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT
14 TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH CERTAIN TAXPAYERS TO FORGIVE TAX
15 LIABILITIES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

18 Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 9, Section 14
19 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

20 "Neither the state nor any county, school district or
21 municipality, except as otherwise provided in this
22 constitution, shall directly or indirectly lend or pledge its
23 credit or make any donation to or in aid of any person,
24 association or public or private corporation or in aid of any
25 private enterprise for the construction of any railroad except

1 as provided in Subsections A through [~~F~~] G of this section.

2 A. Nothing in this section prohibits the state or
3 any county or municipality from making provision for the care
4 and maintenance of sick and indigent persons.

5 B. Nothing in this section prohibits the state from
6 establishing a veterans' scholarship program for Vietnam
7 conflict veterans who are post-secondary students at
8 educational institutions under the exclusive control of the
9 state by exempting such veterans from the payment of tuition.
10 For the purposes of this subsection, a "Vietnam conflict
11 veteran" is any person who has been honorably discharged from
12 the armed forces of the United States, who was a resident of
13 New Mexico at the original time of entry into the armed forces
14 from New Mexico or who has lived in New Mexico for ten years or
15 more and who has been awarded a Vietnam campaign medal for
16 service in the armed forces of this country in Vietnam during
17 the period from August 5, 1964 to the official termination date
18 of the Vietnam conflict as designated by executive order of the
19 president of the United States.

20 C. The state may establish by law a program of
21 loans to students of the healing arts, as defined by law, for
22 residents of the state who, in return for the payment of
23 educational expenses, contract with the state to practice their
24 profession for a period of years after graduation within areas
25 of the state designated by law.

1 D. Nothing in this section prohibits the state or a
2 county or municipality from creating new job opportunities by
3 providing land, buildings or infrastructure for facilities to
4 support new or expanding businesses if this assistance is
5 granted pursuant to general implementing legislation that is
6 approved by a majority vote of those elected to each house of
7 the legislature. The implementing legislation shall include
8 adequate safeguards to protect public money or other resources
9 used for the purposes authorized in this subsection. The
10 implementing legislation shall further provide that:

11 (1) each specific county or municipal project
12 providing assistance pursuant to this subsection need not be
13 approved by the legislature but shall be approved by the county
14 or municipality pursuant to procedures provided in the
15 implementing legislation; and

16 (2) each specific state project providing
17 assistance pursuant to this subsection shall be approved by
18 law.

19 E. Nothing in this section prohibits the
20 legislature from establishing a program that permits the
21 taxation and revenue department to enter into an agreement with
22 a taxpayer to accept less than full payment of a tax liability
23 of the taxpayer if:

24 (1) the legislature establishes requirements
25 with which the taxpayer shall comply to be eligible to enter

1 into the agreement with the taxation and revenue department;

2 and

3 (2) the legislature establishes the
4 circumstances under which the taxation and revenue department
5 may accept less than full payment of a tax liability.

6 ~~[E.]~~ F. Nothing in this section prohibits the
7 state, a county or a municipality from

8 (1) donating land owned by the state, county
9 or municipality for the construction on it of affordable
10 housing;

11 (2) donating an existing building owned by the
12 state, county or municipality for conversion or renovation into
13 affordable housing; or

14 (3) providing or paying the costs of
15 infrastructure necessary to support affordable housing
16 projects.

17 ~~[F.]~~ G. The provisions of Subsection ~~[E]~~ F of this
18 section are not self-executing. Before the described
19 assistance may be provided, enabling legislation shall be
20 enacted by a majority vote of the members elected to each house
21 of the legislature. This enabling legislation shall:

22 (1) define "affordable housing";

23 (2) establish eligibility criteria for the
24 recipients of land, buildings and infrastructure;

25 (3) contain provisions to ensure the

1 successful completion of affordable housing projects supported
2 by assistance authorized pursuant to Subsection [E] F of this
3 section;

4 (4) require a county or municipality providing
5 assistance pursuant to Subsection [E] F of this section to give
6 prior formal approval by ordinance for a specific affordable
7 housing assistance grant and include in the ordinance the
8 conditions of the grant; and

9 (5) require prior approval by law of a
10 specific affordable housing assistance grant by the state. "

11 Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
12 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
13 rejection at the next general election or at any special
14 election prior to that date that may be called for that
15 purpose.
