BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the following agencies in fiscal year 2006 as follows to offset increased public safety expenses because of increased gasoline prices:

(1) to the state fire marshal, two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to be divided among the volunteer and predominently volunteer fire departments; provided that the distribution shall be based on ten percent of each department's current-year distribution from the fire protection fund; and

(2) to the local government division of the
department of finance and administration, one million six
hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,650,000) to be divided
