AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT A PILOT PROGRAM FOR TEACHER TRAINING, STUDENT LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND FAMILY EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR AT-RISK HISPANIC TEENS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal years 2006 and 2007 to support a pilot program that provides teacher training, student leadership development and family education programs and that also provides a culturally based language arts and social science curriculum for at-risk Hispanic teens and family orientation and goal planning initiatives. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general
