AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER; AUTHORIZING WATER PROJECT FINANCING;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--AUTHORIZATION OF
PROJECTS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 72-4A-9 NMSA
1978, the legislature authorizes the New Mexico finance
authority to make loans or grants from the water project fund
to the following political subdivisions for the following
qualifying projects on terms and conditions established by the
water trust board and the New Mexico finance authority:

A. to the Anthony water and sanitation district in
Dona Ana county for a water project;

B. to the city of Bloomfield in San Juan county for
a water project;
