11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PURCHASE
12 VOTING MACHINES FROM CERTAIN COUNTIES.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Four million dollars
16 (\$4,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
17 secretary of state for expenditure in fiscal years 2006 and
18 2007 to purchase voting machines from counties that purchased
19 new voting machines to meet new voting system standards and
20 must now replace those systems with new machines due to
21 legislation enacted by the second session of the forty-seventh
22 legislature. The secretary of state shall sell the voting
23 systems purchased from the counties and deposit the revenue in
24 the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
25 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the
