11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LITERACY PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN IN
12 RURAL AREAS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million dollars
16 (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
17 public education department for expenditure in fiscal years
18 2007 and 2008 to provide integrated in-school, after-school and
19 summer supplementary literacy programs for children from rural
20 areas at a minimum of ten school sites. The literacy programs
21 shall have been previously implemented in rural areas in New
22 Mexico, shall be designed to serve children in kindergarten
23 through eighth grade and shall include pretesting and
24 posttesting assessments. Any unexpended or unencumbered
25 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert
