CAPITAL PROJECTS IN MCKINLEY, SAN JUAN AND CIBOLA COUNTIES

This capital outlay request is revised to read as follows:

- to the aging and long-term services department

TWIN LAKES CHP SENIOR CENTER PARKING LOT IMPROVE

fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to plan, design and construct a parking lot at the senior center in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

- to the capital program fund

NMED DIST 5 OFFICE CONSTRUCT

forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan, design and construct or purchase a district 5 administrative office for the department of environment in Grants in Cibola county

- to the department of environment

GAMERCO WATER & SAN DIST IMPROVE

seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) for improvements to the Gamerco water and sanitation district water system in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO REGIONAL WATER SYSTEM

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct a regional water system in McKinley county

WILLIAMS ACRES WATER & SAN DIST TREATMENT SYSTEM

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan, design and construct the Williams Acres water and sanitation district treatment system project in McKinley county

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YA-TAH-HEY WSD WATER/WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct water system improvements for the Ya-Tah-Hey water and sanitation district in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO RD 1 IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to county road 1 in McKinley county

NIZHONI-MENDOZA RD IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct road improvements to Nizhoni-Mendoza road, including construction of a roadway, bicycle lanes, a pedestrian walkway, an intersection and a bridge, in McKinley county

TSE BONITO BRIDGE

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan, design and construct the Tse Bonito washout bridge on New Mexico highway 264 in McKinley county

TWO GREY HILLS CHP NAVAJO ROUTE 19 FENCE

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct fencing along the Navajo route 19 right of way in the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

MANUELITO CHP POWERLINE CONSTRUCT

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct powerlines in the Manuelito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

MEXICAN SPRINGS CHP WATER LINES

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct water lines in the Mexican Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

RED LAKE CHP FARM BOARD OFFICE BLDG

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct the farm board office complex building in the Red Lake chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

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ROCK SPRINGS CHP MULTIPURPOSE BLDG

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct a multipurpose building in the Rock Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

ROCK SPRINGS CHP POLICE SUBOFFICE

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan, design and construct a police suboffice in the Rock Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TSA-YA-TOH CHAP POWERLINE EXTEND

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct a powerline extension in the Tsa-Ya-Toh chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHP FLEA MARKET FACILITY

thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) to plan, design and construct a flea market facility in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHP OFFICE COMPLEX CONSTRUCT

twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to plan, design and construct a government office complex in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWO GREY HILLS PHOTOVOLTAIC EQUIP

forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to purchase and install solar photovoltaic equipment in the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

MCKINLEY CO HORSE PRESERVE CONSTRUCT

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan, design and construct a horse preserve in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO MULTIPURPOSE INDOOR ARENA

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct a multipurpose indoor arena, including a Native American pavilion, museum and parking facility, in McKinley county

GALLUP BUSINESS INCUBATOR

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and renovate the Gallup business incubator in McKinley county

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GALLUP ECONOMIC RESOURCE CENTER CONSTRUCT

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to construct and equip an economic resource center in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP POLICE FACILITY

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct a police facility, including facilities for the municipal court, in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct transitional housing in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP VETERANS' MEMORIAL

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to construct a veterans' memorial in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP WESTSIDE FIRE STATION

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct the westside fire station in Gallup in McKinley county

NWNM COG BUILDING REMODEL & EQUIP

ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to remodel and equip the county-owned building used by the northwest New Mexico council of governments in Gallup in McKinley county

THOREAU OUTDOOR RECREATION FACILITY CONSTRUCT

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct a recreational facility in Thoreau in McKinley county

SAN JUAN CO ARCHAEOLOGICAL CTR & LIBRARY

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to expand the facilities at the San Juan county archaeological research center and library at Salmon ruins in San Juan county

- to the office of the state engineer

NWNM WATER AUTHORITY

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a mechanical and operational water utility in support of the proposed Navajo-Gallup water supply pipelines to serve northwest New Mexico in McKinley and San Juan counties

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- to the tourism department

GALLUP INDIAN TRIBAL CEREMONIAL OFFICE/LAND

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the intertribal ceremonial office to purchase, acquire, remodel and equip the Gallup Indian tribal ceremonial office in Gallup in McKinley county

- to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico

UNM-GALLUP TECH CENTER & CLASSROOM BLDG

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to develop the site for and plan, design, construct and equip a technology center and classroom building on the Gallup branch campus of the university of New Mexico in McKinley county
