WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., was one of the nation's most important civil rights leaders; and

WHEREAS, his commitment to the principles of nonviolent protest and peaceful civil disobedience contrasted sharply with the violence encountered by civil rights activists; and

United States congress to honor him by designating the third
Monday in January as a national holiday;
