3 B. The elected H class county officials listed in Subsection A of this section, except probate judge, in 4 5 addition to the salaries prescribed shall be entitled to 6 receive as per diem expense the sum of not more than fifteen dollars (\$15.00) while in actual attendance at county 7 8 commission meetings or while engaged in the performance of 9 their official duties for the county. However, the total per 10 diem expense allowance for each elected H class county official listed in Subsection A of this section shall not 11 exceed three hundred fifty dollars (\$350) in any fiscal year. 12 Such per diem expense shall be in addition to any allowance 13 for sheriff's mileage or for other out-of-county expenses 14 15 allowed for all officials by law and shall be budgeted, paid and audited as provided by laws governing expenditures of 16 county funds." 17
