6	WHEREAS, Title 9 of the Education Amendments of 1972, 20	
7	USC, Sections 1681-1688, has caused disparities between men's	
8	and women's collegiate athletic programs; and	
9	WHEREAS, women's ice hockey is gaining popularity	
10	throughout the country; and	
11	WHEREAS, women's ice hockey has been an Olympic sport	
12	since the eighteenth winter Olympic games in Nagano, Japan, in	
13	1998; and	
14	WHEREAS, there are currently limited opportunities for	
15	women attending New Mexico state university to play ice	
16	hockey; and	
17	WHEREAS, the Pan American center at New Mexico state	
18	university may provide a possible venue for ice hockey games;	
19	and	
20	WHEREAS, the addition of women's sports in a timely	
21	manner can reduce the likelihood of forcing the termination of	
22	other sports programs at a university; and	
23	WHEREAS, the proportion of women students at New Mexico	
24	state university continues to be approximately fifty-six	
25	percent of the student body, and the feasibility of adding	SM 23 Page l

women's sports programs should be studied continually;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the board of regents of New Mexico state university be requested to study the feasibility of adapting the Pan American center to accommodate ice hockey games and to study the cost of establishing a division one women's ice hockey program, including a budget for the start-up and annual operating expenses of such a program, including recurring scholarships; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the board of regents of New Mexico state university report the results of this study no later than October 31, 2006 to the chief clerk of the senate; and
