Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 285 requests an appropriation of \$25.0 thousand dollars from the general fund to the Public Education Department for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 for credit recovery, English language learning, and special needs technology services for the Las Vegas Public School District.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

\$ 25.0 Thousand dollars are appropriated from the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
