SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 737, "Fifth Judicial District Methamphetamine Program" appropriates \$50,000 from the general fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts for the purpose of providing funding for a methamphetamine drug education program in the 5th Judicial District.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$50,000 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.

AOC suggests that the appropriation should rather be made to the 5th judicial district attorney or Administrative Office of the District Attorneys.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill is likely intended to make an appropriation to the 5th Judicial District Attorney. The Administrative Office of the Courts does not have methamphetamine education programs.

TECHNICAL ISSUES

AOC suggests amending "administrative office of the courts" on line 17 and replacing it with "fifth judicial district attorney.
