## **SUMMARY**

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 56 creates a new Science and Mathematics Division within the Public Education Department. The bill appropriates \$424 thousand from the general fund to the Public Education Department to establish the division.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$424 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
