SUMMARY

Senate Bill 467 appropriates \$100.0 from the general fund to DCA for the planning and dedication of the Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla State Monument.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Bill 467 appropriates \$100.0 from the general fund to DCA and is recurring. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The legislation would fund the development of a management and interpretive plan for the Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla state monument in preparation for its operation and to fund the dedication of the monument in the fall of 2006.
