#### **SUMMARY**

Senate Bill 564 proposes to appropriate \$43.0 from the general fund in fiscal year 2007 to provide sustainability funding for its 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers program.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Bill 564 appropriates \$43.0 from the general fund and is recurring. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

According to PED, More Independent Schools is now in the third year of a five-year 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC federal grant for after-school/extended learning activities. It has been recommended by the U.S. Department of Education that there be a decrease in 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC continuation awards during the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> years of the projects to encourage grantees to work toward sustainability by obtaining a portion of the continuation funding from other sources. Senate Bill 564 would provide that portion of the funding for this project's 4<sup>th</sup> year.
