SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 680 appropriates \$50 thousand from the general found to the Sports Authority to support a youth track and field program in Colfax county.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$50 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The legislation does not specify whether this appropriation will support a school, county or local track and field program.

The Public Education Department reports a number of benefits to increased physical activity among children, including:

- increased attendance rates.
