19	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 5, Section 5
20	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
21	"The governor shall nominate and, by and with the consent
22	of the senate, appoint all officers whose appointment or
23	election is not otherwise provided for and may remove any
24	officer appointed by [him] <u>the governor</u> unless otherwise
25	provided by law. Should a vacancy occur in any state office,
