PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 2, SECTION 20 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROHIBIT THE TAKING OF PRIVATE PROPERTY BY EMINENT DOMAIN FOR PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OR USE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 2, Section 20 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"A. Private property [shall not] may be taken or damaged for public use [without just compensation] only upon payment of just compensation:

- (1) by public agencies when necessary for the possession, occupation or enjoyment of land by the public at large; or
- (2) by public utilities, pipeline common carriers, those seeking to put water to beneficial use. .159000.4
