A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE FOR ANNUAL REGULAR FORTY-FIVE-DAY SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"[A.] Each regular session of the legislature shall begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January [Every regular session of the legislature convening during an odd-numbered year] and shall remain in session not to exceed [sixty] forty-five days [and every regular session of the legislature convening during an even-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed thirty days]. No special session of the legislature shall exceed thirty days.

5	(2) bills drawn pursuant to special messages
6	of the governor; and
7	(3) bills of the last previous regular session

9	Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
10	shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
11	rejection at the next general election or at any special
12	election prior to that date that may be called for that
13	purpose.
