LEASE OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK--3 4 CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS.--In exercising supervisory control 5 pursuant to Section 15-2-2 NMSA 1978, the radio communications 6 bureau of the communications division of the general services 7 department may lease to a private entity excess capacity on its 8 radio communications property, including buildings, towers or 9 antennas, provided that: 10 the lease conforms with competitive procurement Α. 11 requirements of the Procurement Code; 12 the lease is for an equal value exchange of Β. 13 money or property; 14 C. the secretary of general services certifies that 15 the excess capacity will be available for at least the duration 16 of the lease; 17 if the lease exceeds ten years, the lease is D. 18 first approved by the state board of finance; 19 Ε. the radio communications bureau has submitted to 20 the legislative finance committee a detailed plan for the use 21 of excess capacity being leased and an assessment of how the 22 lease will affect public sector uses and local 23 telecommunications service providers; and 24 income from the leases shall be deposited to the F. 25 credit of the radio communications bureau and used to carry out .163726.2 - 2 -
