14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne hundred thousand dollars
16	(\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the Indian
17	affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 and
18	subsequent fiscal years to provide cultural demonstrations and
19	presentations promoting tobacco cessation among residents of
20	southwestern Cibola county in the region near the Ramah Navajo
21	community by using examples and stories from the traditional
22	Navajo mountain smoke ceremony that are told by traditional
23	artisans, storytellers, elders and medicine men. Any
24	unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a
25	fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.
