16	Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONFINDINGS AND PURPOSE
17	A. The New Mexico legislature finds that it is

support for the delivery of services for small and mid-size manufacturers be used to match federal funds.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. --

One million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 and 2008 to contract for manufacturing extension services. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.

Expenditure of any of the money appropriated in Subsection A of this section is contingent upon the receipt of money from the national institute of standards and technology to operate a manufacturing center in New Mexico that is approved by the national institute of standards and technology.

EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public Section 3. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
