AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DESECRATION OF ROADSIDE MEMORIALS; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DESECRATION OF ROADSIDE MEMORIALS-PENALTY.--

- A. A person shall not knowingly or willfully deface or destroy, in whole or in part, a descanso, also known as a memorial, placed alongside a public road right of way to memorialize a motor vehicle accident that resulted in the death of one or more persons.
- B. A person who violates the provisions of Subsection A of this section is:
