RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR FACULTY INFORMATION IN THE ANNUAL ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT FOR HIGHER EDUCATION: MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 21-1-26.7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1990) Section 1. (1st S.S.), Chapter 4, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"21-1-26.7. ANNUAL ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT. --

The higher education department shall submit an annual accountability report to the governor and to the legislature by December 31. Prior to publication, the department shall distribute a draft of the accountability report to all public post-secondary educational institutions and shall allow comment upon the draft report.

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1	B. The department in consultation with [the] each				
2	public post-secondary educational institution shall develop				
3	and adopt the content and a format for the report, including				
4	the following information:				
5	(1) student progress and success;				
6	(2) student access and diversity;				
7	(3) affordability and cost of educational				
8	services; [and]				
9	(4) public and community service by the				
10	[institutions] <u>institution; and</u>				
11	(5) faculty diversity, orientation,				
12	evaluation, compensation and benefits practices, including:				
13	(a) number and percentage of part-time				
14	and full-time faculty by ethnicity and gender;				
15	(b) number of vacant positions posted,				
16	average number of applicants for each position and percentage				
17	of applicants interviewed for full-time and part-time faculty				
18	positions;				
19	(c) percentage of full-time and				
20	percentage of part-time faculty receiving an annual				
21	performance evaluation that includes peer review and a meeting				
22	with a supervisor;				
23	(d) list of dates and locations for				
24	formal orientation sessions for full-time faculty and a list				
25	of dates and locations for formal orientation sessions for				

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(e) per-credit-hour pay rate for fulltime instructors or lecturers and per-credit-hour pay rate for part-time faculty;

(f) percent salary increase for fulltime faculty and percent salary increase for part-time faculty; and

(g) description of the institution's policy for offering benefits to full-time faculty and to part-time faculty.

C. The department shall make no funding recommendation, capital outlay recommendation, distribution or certification on behalf of any public post-secondary educational institution that has not submitted the information required pursuant to this section."

Section 2. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Three million dollars (\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the higher education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to distribute to the public post-secondary educational institutions so that the institutions may begin to phase in part-time faculty compensation rates that on a per-credit-hour basis equal those of full-time instructors or lecturers.

B. Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the higher education .165438.1

department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to distribute to the public post-secondary educational institutions so that the institutions may begin to phase in the provision of group insurance benefits for part-time faculty.

C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.

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
