"22-8-9. BUDGETS--MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS.--

A budget for a school district shall not be approved by the department that does not provide for:

- a school year consisting of at least [one hundred eighty] two hundred ten full instructional days or the equivalent thereof, exclusive of any release time for inservice training; or
- (2) a variable school year consisting of a minimum number of instructional hours established by the [state

(3) a pupil-teacher ratio or class or teaching load as provided in Section 22-10A-20 NMSA 1978.
