AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; PROVIDING A MINIMUM SALARY FOR CLERKS, SECRETARIES AND BOOKKEEPERS IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the School Personnel Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] UNLICENSED SCHOOL EMPLOYEES--MINIMUM
SALARIES.--School districts shall implement a career salary
framework for clerks, secretaries and bookkeepers that provides
the following:

- A. the minimum salary for clerks shall be:
- (1) for entry level clerks with up to five years' experience, seven dollars fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour or the state minimum wage, whichever is higher;

3	(3) for advanced level clerks with ten to
4	twenty years' experience, thirteen dollars (\$13.00) per hour;
5	B. the minimum salary for secretaries shall be:
6	(1) for entry level secretaries with up to
7	five years' experience, ten dollars (\$10.00) per hour;
8	(2) for intermediate level secretaries with
9	five to ten years' experience, twelve dollars (\$12.00) per
10	hour; and
11	(3) for advanced level secretaries with ten to
12	twenty years' experience, fourteen dollars (\$14.00) per hour;
13	and
14	C. the minimum salary for bookkeepers shall be:
15	(1) for entry level bookkeepers with up to
16	five years' experience, fourteen dollars (\$14.00) per hour;
17	(2) for intermediate level bookkeepers with
18	five to ten years' experience, fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per
19	hour; and
20	(3) for advanced level bookkeepers with ten to
21	twenty years' experience, sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per hour."
22	Section 2. APPROPRIATIONFour million dollars
23	(\$4,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
24	public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008
25	to raise clerks, secretaries and bookkeepers in school

districts to minimum salary levels. The salary increases shall be effective the first full pay period after July 1, 2007. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.
