refusal, when able to do so, to provide them; and

(3) "negligently" refers to criminal negligence and means that a person knew or should have known of the danger involved and acted with a reckless disregard for the safety or health of the child.

B. Abandonment of a child consists of the parent, guardian or custodian of a child intentionally leaving or abandoning the child under circumstances whereby the child may or does suffer neglect. [Whoever] <u>A person who</u> commits abandonment of a child is guilty of a misdemeanor, unless the abandonment results in the child's death or great bodily harm, in which case [he] <u>the person</u> is guilty of a second degree felony.

C. A parent, guardian or custodian who leaves an infant less than ninety days old in compliance with the Safe Haven for Infants Act shall not be prosecuted for abandonment of a child.

D. Abuse of a child consists of a person knowingly, intentionally or negligently, and without justifiable cause, causing or permitting a child to be:

(1) placed in a situation that may endangerthe child's life or health;

(2) tortured, cruelly confined or cruelly punished; or

[Whoever] <u>A person who</u> commits abuse of a child that does not result in the child's death or great bodily harm 2 is, for a first offense, guilty of a third degree felony and 3 for second and subsequent offenses is guilty of a second 4 degree felony. If the abuse results in great bodily harm to 5 the child, [he] the person is guilty of a first degree felony. 6 F. [Whoever] <u>A person who</u> commits negligent abuse 7 of a child that results in the death of the child is guilty of 8 a first degree felony. 9 10 G. [Whoever] <u>A person who</u> commits intentional abuse of a child twelve to eighteen years of age that results 11 in the death of the child is guilty of a first degree felony. 12 H. [Whoever] A person who commits intentional 13 abuse of a child less than twelve years of age that results in 14 the death of the child is guilty of a first degree felony 15 resulting in the death of a child. 16 Ι.
