 - 4. On page 1, line 19, after "2008" insert "that provides:
- (1) parenting education that teaches parents to be the primary teacher and full partners in their child's education;
- (2) early childhood education to prepare children for success in school and life;
- (3) adult literacy education that leads to economic self-sufficiency;
- (4) community resource awareness so that parents are able to help themselves;
- (5) home visits to provide one-to-one guidance on more effective parenting and home teaching skills;
- (6) transportation and other support services that help the families participate on a consistent basis; and
 - (7) regular attendance of participating families".
- 5. On page 1, line 19, before "Any" insert the subsection designation "B.".,
