AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Children's Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] INFORMATION NOT TO BE DISCLOSED ON A PUBLIC ACCESS WEB SITE. -- A state agency or a political subdivision of the state, including a school district, county, municipality or home-rule municipality, shall not disclose on a public access web site maintained by it any information concerning the following:

Α. an arrest or detention of a child; .165903.1
