20	required fee, issue to every qualified applicant a driver's
21	license as applied for. The license shall bear the full name,
22	date of birth, current New Mexico physical or mailing address,
23	a full-face or front-view photograph of the license holder and
24	a brief description of the licensee and the signature of the
25	licensee. A license shall not be valid unless it bears the

3	face the number of times that a person was convicted for
4	driving under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs

7	the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs and has not had
8	another conviction or a license revocation pursuant to the
9	Implied Consent Act and at least four years have passed since
10	the date of the conviction, that person may obtain a license
11	without the indication."
