18	Section 1. A new section of Chapter 22, Article 13 NMSA

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Section 2. APPROPRIATION .--

Α. Ten million five hundred thirty-five thousand four hundred dollars (\$10,535,400) is appropriated from the general fund to the teacher professional development fund for expenditure in fiscal years 2008 and 2009 as follows:

in fiscal year 2008, expenditures from (1) this appropriation shall be allocated to school districts to provide professional development based on two hundred dollars (\$200) for each classroom teacher and one hundred dollars (\$100) for each classroom educational assistant; and

in fiscal year 2009, expenditures from (2) this appropriation shall be allocated to school districts to provide professional development based on two hundred dollars (\$200) for each classroom teacher and one hundred dollars (\$100) for each classroom educational assistant in school districts that have adopted uniform grade and subject curricula.

This appropriation is to provide classroom Β. teachers and educational assistants with professional development, and the money from this appropriation shall not be used for administrative costs of the department or school districts. No money from this appropriation shall be used for out-of-state conferences or meetings.
