### AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION; PROVIDING ADDITIONAL
CIRCUMSTANCES WHEN A PARENT OR GUARDIAN MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR
TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-16-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 224, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-16-6. REIMBURSEMENT OF PARENTS OR GUARDIANS.--A local school board may, subject to regulations adopted by the [state board] department, provide per capita or per mile reimbursement to a parent or guardian:
