AN ACT
RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL RETIREMENT; INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
Section 1. Section 22-11-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 144, as amended) is amended to read:
"22-11-21. CONTRIBUTIONS--MEMBERS--LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS.--
A. Each member shall make contributions to the fund according to the following schedule:
(1) through June 30, 2005, an amount equal to seven and six-tenths percent of the member's annual salary;
(2) from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, an amount equal to seven and six hundred seventy-five thousandths percent of the member's annual salary;

(3) from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007, an amount equal to seven and seventy-five hundredths percent of the member's annual salary;
(4) from July l, 2007 through June 30, 2008, an amount equal to seven and eight hundred twenty-five thousandths percent of the member's annual salary; and
(5) on and after July l, 2008, an amount equal to seven and nine-tenths percent of the member's annual salary.
B. Each local administrative unit shall make an annual contribution to the fund according to the following schedule:
[(1) through June 30, 2005, a sum equal to eight and sixty-five hundredths percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit;
(2) from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, a sum equal to nine and forty-hundredths percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the loeal administrative unit;
(3) from July 1, 2006] (1) through June 30, 2007, a sum equal to ten and fifteen-hundredths percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit;
[(4)] (2) from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, a sum equal to [ten and ninety-hundredths] eleven percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local .167622 .1
administrative unit;
[(5)] (3) from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009, a sum equal to eleven and [sixty-five] seventy-five hundredths percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit;
[(6)] (4) from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, a sum equal to twelve and [four-tenths] one-half percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit;
[(7)] (5) from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011, a sum equal to thirteen and [fifteen-hundredths] onefourth percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit; and
[(8)] (6) on and after July 1, 2011, a sum equal to [thixteen and nine-tenths] fourteen percent of the annual salary of each member employed by the local administrative unit."
