BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION .-- One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to establish a demonstration and research program that will better prepare undergraduate students from smaller universities for successful entry into medical school or other related health fields. Preparation will include a focused undergraduate curriculum, summer science academies, remote learning, medical school entrance exam preparation and mentoring by rural physicians and
