15	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
16	A. One million five hundred thousand dollars
17	(\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human
18	services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008
19	pursuant to Subsection B of this section for the purpose of
20	establishing pilot projects in Taos, Chaves, Hidalgo, Luna and
21	Grant counties in order to improve the quality and increase the
22	efficiency of the health care delivery system in the state
23	through the use of electronic health record systems by health
24	care providers. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
25	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the
