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1 itemized program units are as follows: 2 (1)early childhood education; 3 (2) basic education; special education, adjusted by subtracting 4 (3) 5 the units derived from membership in class D special education 6 programs in private, nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers; 7 (4) bilingual multicultural education; fine arts education; 8 (5) 9 size adjustment; (6) 10 at-risk program; (7) 11 (8) enrollment growth or new district 12 adjustment; 13 special education units derived from (9) 14 membership in class D special education programs in private, 15 nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers; [and] 16 (10) national board for professional teaching 17 standards certification; and 18 (11) charter school student activities. 19 Β.
