## AN ACT

RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; PROHIBITING THE OFF-PREMISES SALE OF REFRIGERATED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; CREATING A PENALTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Liquor Control Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] REFRIGERATED SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
PROHIBITED--PENALTY.--

- A. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for a person holding a license issued pursuant to the Liquor Control Act to sell for consumption off the licensed premises alcoholic beverages that have been refrigerated or otherwise cooled or chilled in any manner.
  - B. A person knowingly violating Subsection A of

this section is guilty of a fourth degree felony and shall be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
