16	Section 1. APPROPRIATION Three hundred thousand
17	dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to
18	the board of regents of New Mexico institute of mining and
19	technology for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to fund the
20	institute for complex additive systems analysis training
21	programs that provide computer security for units of state or
22	local governments, including Indian nations, tribes or
23	pueblos. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
24	the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.
